

West Thames College Supplier Privacy Notice

Privacy Notice (How We Use Supplier Information)

This privacy notice has been prepared in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR") and the Data Protection Act 2018 and explains how West Thames College collects, uses and shares your personal data and your rights in relation to the personal data we hold. This Privacy Notice concerns our processing of personal data of past, present and prospective suppliers to West Thames College.

How We Collect Your Information

West Thames College may collect your personal data in a number of different ways:

- from the information you provide to us as a potential supplier, supplier, or former supplier.
- when you communicate with us by telephone, email or via our website to make enquiries or raise concerns.
- from the information you provide to us when registering with the college as a supplier

The Categories of Supplier Information We Collect, Hold and Share

As a supplier to the college we store and use your information for the purposes of managing our suppliers in respect of the supply of goods and services that our college may need. In order to engage and manage our suppliers, where you are a supplier (or where it is a company you are it's representative) we may collect and store the following types of data about you:

- **Personal Information**: name, home address, occupation, work address, email address, telephone number, photograph, vehicle make, type and registration details, bank account details, CV.
- **Special Categories**: please note that on occasions we may process "special categories" of information about you. This is information revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs or trade union membership, and the processing of genetic data, biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person, data concerning health or data concerning a person's sex life or sexual orientation.

Why We Use This Information

West Thames College collects and uses supplier data:

• for the purposes of managing and operating the college.

The Lawful Basis on Which We Use This Information

Except in the circumstance highlighted below, we process this information on the basis of our legitimate interests:

- we have a legitimate interest in engaging and managing our suppliers; and
- to be able to do so, we need to hold detail of who those suppliers are

Where we are required to hold certain records for health and safety purposes, then we collect and hold those records to comply with that statutory obligation.

Where we hold your bank account details, we do this on the basis that it is necessary for us to perform our contract with you.

Storing Data

Subject to any other notices that we may provide to you, West Thames College may retain your data after your association with us has come to an end, as required by regulatory organisations.

Who We Share Information With

West Thames College may share the personal information that you give us with the following organisations (or types of organisation):

Government departments and agencies where we have a statutory duty to provide information

Why We Share Information

We do not share information about our suppliers with anyone without consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so.

Automated Decision Making

We do not make any decision about you based solely on automated decision making.

How We Transfer Your Personal Information Outside Europe

We do not store or transfer your personal data outside Europe.

Requesting Access to Your Personal Data

Under data protection legislation, suppliers have the right to request access to their information. To make a request for your personal information contact <u>generaldata@west-thames.ac.uk</u>

You also have the right to:

- object to processing of personal data that is likely to cause, or is causing, damage or distress.
- prevent processing for the purpose of direct marketing
- object to decisions being taken by automated means
- in certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed; and
- claim compensation for damages caused by a breach of the Data Protection regulations.

Where processing of your personal data relies on your consent and you later withdraw that consent, we may not be able to continue to provide all or some aspects of our services to you and/or it may affect the provision of those services.
