

# **Provider Access Policy**

#### Introduction

This policy statement sets out the college's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the college for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the college's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997 and the government's statutory guidance for governing bodies, school leaders and school staff.

## Student Entitlement

All students at the college are entitled to:

- find out about technical education qualifications, higher education and apprenticeships opportunities and, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education, higher education and apprenticeships
- understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.
