How to apply for Financial Support or Free Meals



To apply for Financial Support, you must complete your enrolment and obtain your student ID card. (HE students and those studying full-cost courses are not eligible).

Please follow the instructions in this document.



What you will need to apply for bursary

- 1. Student ID number.
- 2. Student Email address and log-in details.
- **3.** Immigration Documents: Your Passport, Home Office Card, Birth Certificate (UK Only) or Settlement Documents.
- 4. Your income or benefit documents:
- If you or your parents are in receipt of Universal Credits 2 Full UC statements in PDF format and last two month's bank statements showing UC payments
- If you or your parents are in receipt of Income Support, Job Seekers Allowance, ESA or Pension Credits – The letter from DWP dated 2022 and 3 recent bank statements showing benefit income
- If your family income is from sources not mentioned above, you can drop in to bursary office to speak to a member of staff

How to complete bursary application

When you are ready with your documents follow these steps to complete your online application.

- 1. Visit: https://westthames.paymystudent.com/portal/
- 2. Enter your full college email address and the password you use to login to college computers
- 3. Answer all questions correctly If you or your family is in receipt of Universal Credits, you must tick this option.
- 4. Upload your documents Universal Credits Statements in PDF format or benefit letters scanned copies or clear pictures of all pages
- 5. Upload bank statements PDF statements or clear pictures of paper statements-All pages
- 6. Accepted document formats are: JPG, GIF, DOC, DOCX, PDF, PNG

Financial support checklist

There are various ways that you may be entitled to financial help while you are studying at West Thames College.

All payments are made subject to 90% attendance (the College expect 100% attendance)

For students under 19

Vulnerable Bursary

For students who are aged 16-18 on 31 August 2022 and either:

- In care or leaving care (social services) or
- Receiving Income Support or Universal Credits and living independently or
- On Employment & Support Allowance with Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments.

Discretionary Bursary

For students who are aged 16-18 on 31 August 2022 or aged 19 continuining the same course and either:

- You or your parents/guardians are in receipt of benefits* or
- Have a family income of not more than £25,000.

* If on Universal Credit, your family income including UC must be less then £25,000.

For students over 19

Discretionary Learner Support (DLS)

To be eligible for DLS, all of the following must apply:

- You are aged 19-23 on an FE course up to and including Level3, or aged 24+ on an FE course up to and including Level 2, *and*
- You are in receipt of benefits, and
- You have a family income of not more than £28,000.

Loan Bursary

To be eligible, you must be aged 19+ and:

- Be studying on a course at Level 3 or higher, and
- Be in receipt of the Advanced Learner Loan or have had your Loan approved by the Student Loans Company, *and*
- Be in receipt of benefits*, and
- Have a family income of not more than £35,000.
- * If on Universal Credit, your family income including UC must be less then £35,000.
